## Admission Process at Madha Engineering College (MEC)

Madha Engineering College (MEC) offers admissions through a dual-mode system, ensuring a balanced intake of students via government and institutional admission:

### 1. Admission Channels

- Anna University State-Level Single Window System (50% of seats): Half of the seats are filled through this centralized counseling process managed by Anna University, adhering to Tamil Nadu Government reservation norms.
- Management Quota (50% of seats):

  The remaining seats are allocated based on merit through the college's management quota, which may follow separate guidelines set by the institution.

#### 2. Reservation Policies

- Seats under the Single Window System are subject to the Tamil Nadu State Government's
  reservation regulations, covering categories such as Backward Classes (BC), Most
  Backward Classes (MBC), and Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST).
- These policies are typically outlined in Anna University's admission guidelines and apply to both regular and lateral entry candidates.

### 3. Roster System

• The government uses a "roster" system, which is a rotating schedule, to determine which categories are given priority for a particular seat in each admission cycle.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

- Open Category: Candidates must secure a minimum of 50% in all relevant subjects.
- **SC/ST Category:** Candidates are required to **pass all subjects**, with no minimum percentage specified.
